21. SCRUTINY – SPECIAL RESTRICTIONS

Motorkhana - Approved helmets in accordance with Schedule D of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport are to be worn in ALL specials. Apparel shall be in accordance with Schedule D of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport. All vehicles must comply with Schedule A and Group 4H of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport. Vehicles must be adequately muffled to comply with noise restrictions. Fuel must be in accordance with Schedule G of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.

A current and valid CAMS Level 2NS/2NSJ Competition Licence or superior, and Club Membership Card of a NSW or ACT CAMS-Affiliated Car Club and vehicle Log Book (if issued) must be presented at document check. Any camera or video recording device mounted in or on a competition vehicle must be installed prior to scrutineering and approved by the Chief Scrutineer.

22. CLASSES

Motorkhana Classes:

- Class A Production Vehicles Wheelbase up to 2150mm
- Class B Production Vehicles Wheelbase 2151 to 2390mm
- Class C Production Vehicles Wheelbase 2391 to 2574mm
- Class D Production Vehicles Wheelbase 2575mm and over.
- Class F Front Wheel Drive Specials
- Class G Rear Wheel Drive Specials
- Class H Production Vehicle Based Specials

Non Production 4WS (4 Wheel Steering) and Non-Production 4wd vehicles are not permitted

Motorkhana Categories:

Category J Juniors
Category LP Ladies in Production Vehicles
Category LS Ladies in Specials

(Nomination in a category does not exclude a driver from competing for class awards)

23. RESULTS, PRIZES AND TROPHIES

State and Multi-Club Events will be scored separately and as follows.

STATE: Two runs at each test with the fastest time used in the results. Results shall be determined by the lowest aggregate of elapsed times on the tests completed, inclusive of penalties. Timing shall be to 0.01 of a second.

MULTI-CLUB: All times used in the results. Results shall be determined by the lowest aggregate of elapsed times on the tests completed, inclusive of penalties. Timing shall be to 0.01 of a second.

PRIZES/TROPHIES: 1st Outright, 1st in each Class (minimum 3 entries in Class), 1st in each Category (minimum 3 entries in Category).

Other awards at the Director's discretion. All awards are mutually exclusive.

24. PASSENGERS

This Event will include a Motor Sport Passengers Ride Activity (MSPRA) which shall be run under and in accordance with the CAMS MSPRA Policy and Motorkhana Regulations.

STATE: Only limited experience Junior Drivers are allowed to carry an experienced senior Passenger (Instructor) for the purpose of guidance. All Junior Drivers carrying a Passenger during competition are not eligible to score championship points in a State Motorkhana Championship Event. Times achieved by a Driver with a Passenger shall not be used as a basis for the application of penalties to other Drivers.

MULTI-CLUB: Passengers are welcome and encouraged.

NOTE FOR ALL PASSENGERS

1. All Passengers shall comply with the CAMS Motor Sport Passenger Ride Activity Policy.
2. The suitability of the Passenger is at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course and all Passengers must have permission from the Clerk of the Course.
3. No person under 18 years of age is permitted to ride with a Junior Driver.
4. Each Passenger must complete the CAMS MSPRA Passenger Ride Entry Form before any test. Drivers are also required to fill out a CAMS MSPRA Passenger Ride Entry Form to ride as a Passenger. All completed CAMS MSPRA Passenger Ride Entry Forms will be forwarded to CAMS as per CAMS MSPRA Policy requirements.
5. All Passengers shall wear the same protective gear as a Driver in accordance with Schedule D of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport and must pass Scrutiny.
6. All Passengers shall be fitted and restrained as required for each Automobile with consideration for their physical attributes and must pass Scrutiny.
7. Only one Passenger is permitted in the vehicle with the Driver at any time during a test.
8. A Briefing must be attended by each Driver and Passenger (and guardians of each Passenger if Passenger is under 18 years of age) conducted by the Clerk of the Course prior to the MSPRA commencing.

25. The CAMS Permit will be displayed at the start of the Event.

26. The Organisers may refuse any entry in accordance with NCR 83 of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.

27. Entries will be accepted in order of receipt by the Event Secretary. First preference will be given to State Motorkhana Entrants. Competition numbers shall be allocated at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course. Upon receipt of entries the Organisers will allocate competition numbers by class. Eg: A1 to A10, B1 to B10 etc for state competitors and 1,2,3,4,5 etc for Multi-Club Competitors. This will assist in minimising greatly unequal conditions amongst classes where necessary for State Competitors.
28. Entries from Competitors under 18 years of age must be counter signed / consented to Parent/Guardian.
29. Personal Accident Insurance is provided by the purchase of a CAMS Level 2NS/2NSJ Licence or superior (2NS/2NSJ is the minimum requirement). Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by CAMS in relation to the event. Further details can be found in the CAMS Insurance Handbook, available at www.cams.com.au
30. Start and Finish procedures shall be in accordance with Article 13 of the National Motorkhana Code. Running order shall be at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course, but in general will be the State field followed by the Multi-Club field.
31. Event Organisers reserve the right to cancel, abandon or postpone the Event in accordance with NCR 59 of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.
32. Protests must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.
33. Any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty(ies) for a breach in accordance with the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy and/or the CAMS Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy as published on the CAMS website. Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day. Accordingly, any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may also be tested for the presence of alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the CAMS Standard Operating Procedure for Breath Alcohol Testing.
34. Food and drinks will be available to purchase at the venue.
35. Toilet facilities are available near the TAFE Library C21, approx. 150m from Motorkhana area.
36. Fuel is not available at the venue, the closest service station is on the corner of Grady St and Quakers Hill Parkway, a 5 minute drive away.
